
FRITZ SAUCKEL



Sauckel, Hitler's chief of slave-labor recruitment, asked to see his lawyer in this note that Charles possesses.



Fritz Sauckel was responsible for mobilizing German and foreign workers for the Nazi military industrial complex. Sauckel oversaw the deportation of some five million workers from their homes in the occupied territories, instructing that these slave laborers be exploited "to the highest degree possible at the lowest conceivable degree of expenditure."

Sauckel was sentenced to death and hanged at Nürnberg.
